Thursday $25^{\text {th }}$ James the Apostle - Give thanks for the work, ministry, and writing of James - reflect on these challenging words, Be doers of the word, and not merely hearers who deceive themselves. For if any are hearers of the word, they are like those who look at themselves in a mirror; for they look at themselves and, on going away, immediately forget what they are like, but those who look into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and persevere, being not hearers who forget but doers who act - they will be blessed in their doing. (James 1:22-25)
